

RESOLUTION NO. 1748

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA FALLS, MONTANA, DESIGNATING HERITAGE DAYS 2017 AS AN OFFICIAL ACTIVITY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA FALLS AND DESIGNATING PERSONS RESPONSIBLE FOR PLANNING THE EVENTS OF HERITAGE DAYS 2017.

WHEREAS, the Designated Planners of Heritage Days 2017 are desirous of being officially recognized by the City as such and of having Heritage Days 2017 recognized and approved as an official City activity; and

WHEREAS, the persons designated hereby as Planners of Heritage Days 2017 began and continued to plan Heritage Day events starting on or about January 2017, and made planning decisions, collected and expended funds and approved or disapproved of events independent of City involvement; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the City of Columbia Falls that the City designate such individuals and approve said activity.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA FALLS, MONTANA AS FOLLOWS:

Section One: That the following individuals are designated as Planners of Heritage Days 2017:

and that all acts of said persons heretofore performed or to be performed in furtherance of their duties as Planners of Heritage Days 2017 are hereby designated as such, with the exception that the following activities cannot and are not sanctioned or approved by the City: air shows, street dances, circuses, rodeos, fireworks, animal racing, carnivals, vehicle racing or burnout exhibitions, rock concerts, water sports, boxing or other martial arts, and skateboard exhibitions, competitions or racing, and the wild horse drive approved by MT Department of Transportation.

WHEREAS, the Planners shall approve only sanctioned and planned events on privately owned property to be used under a temporary land-use agreement between the private property owners and the City.

Section Two: That Heritage Days 2017 and all activities relating thereto are hereby recognized as an official activity of the City of Columbia Falls, with the exceptions set forth in Section One of this Resolution.
