

RESOLUTION NO. 1760

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA FALLS, MONTANA, DESIGNATING THE GLACIER GLOW RUN AS AN OFFICIAL ACTIVITY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA FALLS.

WHEREAS, the City of Columbia Falls is hosting the Glacier Glow Run on September 15, 2017 and the City is recognizing the event an official City activity; and

WHEREAS, a significant portion of the event will be held on city streets, property and parks; and

WHEREAS, the City of Columbia Falls submitted a facility use permit to School District #6 for the use of Glacier Gateway Elementary field for this event to avoid having runners on the portion of the truck route adjacent to the Glacier Gateway Elementary field on 6th Ave West; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the City of Columbia Falls that the City approve said activity.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA FALLS, MONTANA AS FOLLOWS:

Section One: That the City is hosting the Glacier Glow Run on September 15, 2017 in cooperation with the non-profit benefactor of the event, Glacier Boys and Girls Club, and the event promoters, Daily Inter Lake and the Hungry Horse News.

Section Two: To enhance event safety, the City of Columbia Falls requested the use of Glacier Gateway Elementary School District #6 track and field area to keep runners off of the portion of the truck route adjacent to the track and field, 6th Ave. West between 5th St. West and 3rd St. West.

Section Three: That the Glacier Glow Run and all activities relating thereto are hereby recognized as an official activity of the City of Columbia Falls, with the exception of those held on privately-owned property.
