

Columbia Falls Urban Project

On April 30th, 2018 construction work will begin on the final phase of the Columbia Falls Urban Project. This project will feature asphalt paving, asphalt milling, sidewalks, curb and gutter, signing, striping, chip seal, and signal improvements. Project working days will be Monday through Saturday, with a projected finish date anticipated for the month of July, weather permitting.

The project begins on National Highway Route-US 2 at mile marker 134.2, just east of the Highway 40 Junction and proceeds easterly to mile marker 137.4, just east of the Flathead River bridge.

Motorists can expect single lane traffic at the start of construction and should watch for signs, workers and equipment in the area and travel at posted speeds until signs indicate the work zone has ended. Fines double in work zones.
